Narrative

On Saturday, February 04, 2016 at approximately 0154 hours I, Deputy Steven Jackley #4810, responded to 18944 Peckham Drive (A10) in reference to a DOC - Noise (2405).

Suspect 1:

"Jackson, Christine" her parents own the residence, but she was not fully identified

Janice reported the loud noise coming from the residence located directly next to her residence. This residence, 18944 Peckham Drive, is often rented out and often the source of loud noise complaints by some of the nearby residents.

On this occasion, TCSO arrived on scene and observed noise from music and loudly talking individuals coming from the residence. Contact was made at the front door where a female subject advised that she would turn down the music and try to quiet her guests. I arrived on scene and was meeting with Janice at the end of her driveway, at the roadway, when the young female from next door walked out to meet us. This female subject stated that her name was "Christine Jackson" and that her parents owned the residence being complained upon. Christine walked past me and onto Janice's driveway where she started to angrily speak at Janice. I advised Christine to return to her property as she appeared to be intoxicated and I did not want her to escalate this confrontation. Christine did return to her driveway and spoke with me briefly.

Christine complained that her neighbors have been banging on her residence all evening and that she felt like she was being targeted for staying in this residence. I told Christine that she just as much right to call the police if she felt that she was being victimized in any way. Furthermore, Christine said that she was hosting a party and that her neighbors were ruining her "low key Friday night." I advised Christine that she was contacted for the DOC - Noise and she advised that she would keep the volume of her party at this level, or below, for the rest of the night.

Christine calmly returned to the residence.
